

CODE OF CONDUCT

All spectators, members, players, parents, volunteers and committee are required to comply with this Code of Behavior, you must meet the following requirements with regard to your conduct during any activity held by the Moama Football Netball Club (MFNC)

The code of conduct aims to provide a safe environment for participation. Aggressive, threatening or other inappropriate behaviour by members, their families, their friends, and other sporting personnel while attending a game or event will not be tolerated.

All members must:

- Follow the appropriate code of conduct imposed by the Murray Football Netball League, AFL & Netball Victoria
- Lead by example and respect all Players, Coaches, Umpires, Volunteers and spectators.
- Physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated
- Respect the rights and worth of every person, regardless of their age, race, gender, ability, cultural background, sexuality or religion.
- Respect the facilities and equipment of their own and opposing clubs
- Recognise all volunteers who give up their valuable time;
- Not publicly criticise Umpires and instead raise personal concerns with Club Officials in private
- Not engage in violence, physical and/or verbal intimidation, abuse or conduct toward any person.
- Not to enter the field of play in any sanctioned Competition Match unless granted permission by an Official to do so
- Not make or post inappropriate, offensive or discriminatory comments in public including via social media, about Players, Clubs, Umpires, Officials, the AFL, or the League. Social media includes, but is not limited to, email, instant messaging, text messages, phone messages, digital images, website postings (including but not limited to Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, Instagram, websites and blogs).



CODE OF CONDUCT

Players:

As well as the general code of conduct as a player at MFNC, you are offered a great opportunity and as such have some extra responsibilities. As well as the general code of conduct players are also required to ensure comply with the following, this includes travelling to and from games and training:

- Promote fair play over winning at any cost.
- Act within the rules and spirit of your sport.
- Maintain a high standard of personal behavior at all times.
- Applaud all good play, by your own team and opponents.
- Be honest in your attitude and preparation to training. Work equally hard for yourself and your team.
- Be a responsible team member, Always be on time, Encourage and assist all players, Attend all training sessions, Ensure you always bring the appropriate, uniform and equipment to training and/or matches.
- Co-operate with coaches and staff in relation to programs that adequately prepare you for competition.
- Do not engage in practices that affect sporting performance (alcohol, tobacco and drug use)
- Abide by and respect decisions, without argument or bad temper from umpires, coaches and volunteers
- For senior players - attend after match awards and club functions where possible. This ensures you can socialise with your club members, supporters, sponsors and fellow players and gain the most out of your sport.

Volunteers:

When representing Moama Football Netball Club as a volunteer, as well as the general code of conduct players are also required to ensure they:

- Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others.
- Be professional in and accept responsibility for your actions. Your language, presentation, manners and punctuality should reflect high standards.
- Resolve conflicts fairly and promptly through established procedures.
- Maintain strict impartiality.
- Be aware of your legal responsibilities.
- Ensure activities, equipment and facilities are safe and appropriate to the ability level of participating players.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Coaches:

All coaches are required to agree to and sign the MFNC coaches code of conduct as well as the appropriate coaches' code of conduct for the AFL or Netball Victoria before undertaking coaching roles. This code of conduct can be found [HERE](#)

Committee:

All committee members are required to agree to and sign the MFNC committee member code of conduct as well as the appropriate code of conduct for both the AFL or Netball Victoria when elected. This code of conduct can be found [HERE](#)



FOOTBALL

PRE SEASON

Pre-season training is announced via the clubs socials and all are welcome to attend.

Generally the Seniors are the first to return to training with the Under 17's and Under 14's who play in the Murray League being next. This to ensure adequate time for fitness and skills development before the start of the season which is much earlier for the MFNL teams than our other leagues.

Our Shepparton District Junior Football League teams are generally next to start training, often in mid February, this is decided each year after consultation with coaches and the league.

Training for our Goulburn Campase Junior Football League teams often starts late Feb/early March. This is to ensure our juniors are able to manage the training requirements of football and don't burn out before the season is completed.

There is no requirement to complete registration before attending pre-season training

REGISTRATION & FEES

The registration fee covers Player Insurance, AFL Victoria Affiliation Fees, tape if required (MFNL only) and football equipment. Players are unable to participate in games until the registration forms are complete and payment of the fee is made.

Please note that at least one parent of a MFNL junior player must be a member of the Moama Football Netball Club.

Full payment of membership must be paid prior to the first match. If a player does not make payment on or before this date then they will not be permitted to play for the club until they have done so.

This is a directive from the AFLV under its affiliation and will not be compromised due to their insurance cover

FOOTBALL

PLAYER INSURANCE

All players must be financial members of the Moama Football Netball Club to be eligible for medical cover.

The MFNC recommends that all players have Private Health Insurance and Ambulance cover. (Private Health Cover is an obligation required by all AFLV Contracted Players).

Ambulance cover is provided through Ambulance Victoria.

Single Membership 12 months: \$48.35

Family Membership 12 months: \$96.70

Insurance cover is provided through Jardine Lloyd & Thompson in Affiliation with the Australian Football League Victoria. Players are covered for 90% reimbursement of non Medicare medical costs and ambulance expenses. The remaining amount of 10% is the responsibility of the players or the players Private Health Insurance Fund if cover is provided.

A \$50.00 excess per claim will apply and be payable by the player.

A maximum of \$7500.00 will be paid per injury claim. This amount may include Ambulance if the player has no subscription to Ambulance prior to making a claim. Ambulance will limit funds available for remainder of claim. Capital Benefits \$250,000 (\$50,000 for U18).

What does your insurance cover?

The medical policy covers treatment that is not claimable in any way through Medicare. This means treatments such as Physiotherapy, Chiropractic, Private Hospital, Ambulance, Acupuncture, Podiatry, Osteopathy and Rehabilitation Equipment.

Quad/Para Benefit for juniors and seniors cover is now \$1,000,000

Please note that after \$200.00 worth of treatment from anyone of the above providers, a referral from a doctor must be obtained.

What does your insurance not cover?

This Medical policy does not cover anything that can be claimed through Medicare. This means that any charges for treatments from a Doctor, Surgeon, Anaesthetist or Surgeon's Assistant are not covered. It also means that charge for X-Rays and Private Hospitals are not covered. MRI Scans will not be covered without a Medicare Number.

FOOTBALL

PLAYER INSURANCE (CONT)

Where and when are you covered?

The Players Insurance covers all players when involved in any of the following activities for the MFNC:

- Playing in club and representative games, competitions or performance organised by the club.
- Participating in training, practice sessions or official functions arranged by the club.
- Travelling to or from the club and representative games competitions or performances.
- Engaged in organised social or administrative activities of the club.

What are the major policy exclusions?

The major player insurance policy exclusions are:

- Once a player returns to training/playing the claim is closed.
- If the player has been under the influence of Alcohol or Drugs (Non-prescription) while on or off the field.
- If the player has committed or attempted any criminal act (Including assault).
- If the player has any pre-existing conditions i.e., asthma, heart condition etc.

Loss of Income/Wages - Optional

There is cover available to players, however this cover is an additional option and the costs are to be covered by the player.

Submitting a claim

The player must make contact with Jeff Billing (add number) or Sam Eddy as soon as possible. All claims must be submitted to JTL within 28 days of the injury occurring. If a claim is not submitted to JTL within this period then it will be denied without question. This is a ruling from JTL not the MFNC.

The MFNC will not reimburse any player for outstanding accounts or claims in relation to player insurance

FOOTBALL

AGE GROUPS

A player is eligible to play in an age group only if they are of that age prior December 31 of that year.

TRAINING SESSIONS

Training sessions for the Senior and Reserve grades of the MFNC will be held every Tuesday and Thursday evenings prior to regular home and away matches. The location and scheduling of other training sessions will be at the discretion of the coaching staff.

Throughout the year players will be requested to conduct and assist Junior teams with training.

Training Times

Season training times will be as follows or at the discretion of team coaches. Training sessions are compulsory. If a player is ill or injured or unable to attend training, they must notify the coach.

U14 MFNL	Tuesday / Thursday	4.30-6.00pm
U17 MFNL	Tuesday / Thursday	5.00-6.30pm

All other teams on decision of the coach and availability of the ground

TEAM SELECTIONS (SENIORS ONLY)

All team lists will be approved by the MFNC Executive Committee prior to the season. All teams will then be selected on a weekly basis at the discretion of the coaching staff and selection committee. All players are required to attend training at the club during the week prior to any home and away matches to be eligible for selection. This shall not apply if the coach and the selection committee are made aware of and are satisfied with the reason for any players absence from training.

PLAYER WELFARE

The Moama Football Netball Club's Player Representative is Adam Milner (on (add number)

If a player has any dispute or problem with the function of the club in all capacities including player conditions, player incentives etc, then that player must direct it to the Player Representative.

The Player Representative will direct players to the appropriate committee members for any other advice on matters not reflective to this role.

JUNIOR FOOTBALL

FINALS - GCJF

In the Goulburn Campaspe Junior Football League (GCJFL) the Under 10's and Under 12's competitions finish their seasons with a Lightning Premiership day.

In the Under 14's GCJFL the final series is based on a top four, this includes two semi-finals and a Grand Final the following week. For each team that doesn't finish in the top four a Lightning Premiership is held.



FINALS - SDJFL

For the Shepparton District Junior Football League the Under 16's and Youth Girls teams follow the final five system, followed by four weeks of finals.



VOLUNTEER ROLES

To ensure that kids get the opportunity to play each week, we need lots of help. Make sure you chat with your child's Team Manager to offer your help. Each team needs a goal umpiring, time keeper and shifts in the canteen.

These roles are very straight forward and direction and support will be provided by.



FOOTBALL

UNIFORMS

The Moama uniform is black shorts and socks, with a black and white jumper that is supplied by the club.

All MFNL players are expected that they will arrive and leave the club wearing a club polo shirt. This is to ensure that the club is represented as a professional organisation.

During the game all players (junior and senior) teams are to wear black football shorts (white are required for games against Tongala and Numurkah) and black socks which can be purchased from Intersports Echuca, any queries contact Sam Eddy 0400 836 327.

Jumpers are supplied by the club and are to be handed in at the end of each game for cleaning by the Club.

Helmets and mouth guards are compulsory for Under 10/12's in the GCJFL and highly recommended for all players. Helmets will be provided by the club, Mouth guards supplied by players.

CLUB FUNCTIONS

All players must attend compulsory club functions and events.

Players will be required to fulfil rostered duties throughout the season, these include football match day duties, canteen and bar.

NETBALL

PRE-SEASON

Netball pre-season training normally happens in the preceding weeks before try-outs and is a good way to get you match fitness up and limit your chance of injuries and is strongly recommended by the club for anyone wanting to play during the season. Pre-season dates will be announced on Facebook. All senior netballers are welcome to attend pre-season but you must have current insurance through the Victorian Netball Association (VNA) to be able to participate. (see insurance)

TRY OUTS

All players must register to attend tryouts using the advertised method.

Our club supports a fair and open process for the selection of teams. We believe that sport should be safe, enjoyable, inclusive and maximise individual participation and skill-set. Our club acknowledges that positive experiences in our junior competition will contribute to a lifelong love of sport.

For juniors to ensure a fair selection process, the selection panel will consist of one Netball Committee Member, the Coach and an independent member of the community who is unaffiliated with the club but with netball experience.

Our senior selection is completed by the relevant coach, with all team lists approved by the MFNC Executive Committee prior to the season. All teams will then be selected on a weekly basis at the discretion of the coaching staff.

If a player is unavailable to attend any trials due to injury, illness or other extenuating circumstances, an application should be submitted in writing to the Netball Director/coach before the first trial date if possible. Once selection trials have started, contact should be made by phone as soon as possible.

The final teams will be announced one week after the last tryout by appropriate means of communication. Successful players will be notified by a phone call and/or text message, whilst unsuccessful players will expect a text message to advise.

TRAINING

Season training times will be advised by team coaches.

Training sessions are compulsory. If a player is ill or injured or unable to attend training, they must notify the coach. Text message and emails are NOT acceptable. Players that don't attend training without advising their coach may not be considered to start in that week's match.

Its advised that all players bring a drink bottle to all training sessions.

UNIFORMS

The Moama Football Netball Club requires all player to purchase the approved dress . Dresses are available for purchase from the club, as part of registration on [MyNetball website](#).

Club polo's MUST be worn on game day.

The Moama Football Netball Club prohibits the usage of the club name or logo on all end of season shirts, hats, stubby holders etc.

GAME DAY

Players are expected to be dressed and ready for pre-game warm up 30 minutes before the game. This allows players to warm up appropriately and for coaches and team managers to organize teams. Please ensure that if you require strapping this must be done prior to warm up commencement.

VOLUNTEERS

Scorer

Each team must supply one scorer for each game. Each team will either prepare a parent/player roster for scoring duty or nominate a regular scorer.

Both team scorers must sit together for the entire match and must use the Murray Netball League official score sheet. Scorers must sign the score sheet and ensure that both team captains and umpires sign the score sheet. A time keeper must be supplied for all home games.

Its the time keepers responsibility to make sure that the umpires are notified 60 seconds before the end of each quarter and to sound the siren at the end of each quarter and the game.

The Time keeper also manages the extension of time due to injury. Instructions are provided at the timekeepers table

Team manager

The Team Manager is responsible for communication with coaches and players and assists the coach during training and game day matches. Team Managers will be required to complete and organize weekly score sheets and awards, distribute any information to players and a second contact person for players. Team Managers are required to hold a NSW working with children check.
